



SAFETY LINEUP

At this time, we require all guests to follow this lineup of **9** procedures designed to protect you, your family and the Hall of Fame team during your museum visit.

1	NOT FEELING WELL	If you are not feeling well, please do not enter the Museum and plan to visit another day. You may enjoy our online content from home at baseballhall.org . To help ensure your safety our staff is being provided with daily health screenings.
2	TIMED ADMISSION TICKETS	To limit museum capacity, timed admission tickets are required for entry and can be purchased at baseballhall.org prior to arrival.
3	FACE MASKS	Per New York State guidelines, we are requiring the use of face masks for all staff and guests. Free single-use masks will be available at the Museum entrance for visitors who do not have one.
4	PHYSICAL DISTANCING	Please practice physical distancing by maintaining a minimum distance of six feet from those outside your party.
5	DIRECTIONAL MARKERS	Please follow directional markers where they appear within Museum exhibits.
6	HAND SANITIZER	Guests are encouraged to use the hand sanitizer stations positioned throughout the Museum, as well as thorough hand-washing in the restrooms.
7	ELEVATOR	Please take the stairs if you are able. The elevator is reserved for those who are unable to use the stairs and is designated for use by one visiting party at a time.
8	STYLUS	Guests will be given a rubber-tipped stylus to use when interacting with touch-screens and buttons within Museum exhibits and in the elevator. Please do not use your hands.
9	MUSEUM STORE	The Museum Store is open. A ticket to the Museum is not necessary for entry. Prior to entry, please see guidelines posted at the Museum Store.
